

Dixon Elevator Harvest Policy

Effective 9/1/2024

Grains delivered will be applied to all open contracts first. Then unless notified otherwise, all un-contracted grain will go into open storage.

You will have 10 days from your last load to price before they are placed into Deferred Pricing. Storage will then start from the average of the date of delivery.

Stored grains will be priced using the nearby bid; and cannot be forward contracted

Any split tickets need to be addressed at time of delivery, or prior.

We will have limited amount of warehouse receipt space available on a first come first serve basis, taking into account customers who have warehoused with us in the past.

Corn

Open store: \$.0015 per bu/day (\$.045 per bu/month)

No Minimum storage charge

Stored corn will be averaged and then shrunk

1.5% to 14.5 with \$.04 per point moisture dock

Soybeans

\$.0018 per bu/day (\$.054 per bu/month)

No Minimum storage charge

EX: 1000bu of 13.7% Beans

will be a 3% shrink net 970 bu

Test weight discount will be \$.02 per Lb. from 53.9 to 50, \$.04 per Lb below 49.9

Damage will be \$.02 per point from 5.1 to 7%, \$.04 per point 7.1-10%. Over 10% will be \$.05 and could be rejected

Bugs will be \$.10 per bu discount
